SYNOPSIS

Morupule B Power Station operates a wide range of lifting equipment and elevators essential for its power generation and maintenance activities. To ensure compliance with the **Botswana Factories Act (Chapter 44:01)** and to uphold the highest safety standards, Morupule B has implemented a structured inspection and maintenance program for all lifting equipment and elevators.

In accordance with the Factories Act requirements:

- Statutory inspections of all lifting equipment and elevators are conducted every six (6) months by a competent and certified inspector. This ensures that all equipment is fit for use, structurally sound, and mechanically safe.
- Colour coding of lifting equipment is carried out at three (3) month intervals. This system allows for easy visual identification of the inspection status and promotes prompt removal of untested or unsafe equipment from service.
- All lifting devices are clearly marked with safe working loads, and operated only by trained personnel, as stipulated under Section 35 of the Factories Act.
- **Inspection certificates** and **maintenance records** are maintained and readily available for review by statutory authorities and internal audits.
- Immediate **reporting and investigation** of lifting equipment faults, failures, or near misses is enforced to maintain workplace safety.

Morupule B's proactive approach—anchored in strict adherence to the six-month statutory inspection regime and the quarterly colour coding system—not only fulfils legal obligations but also significantly enhances the reliability, safety, and operational readiness of its lifting equipment and elevators.

Through these measures, Morupule B reinforces its commitment to protecting the lives of its employees, safeguarding assets, and ensuring continuous power generation operations.

Given this synopsis, it is recommended to carry out statutory inspection for lifting equipment & elevators at Morupule B Power Station.
