BPC ROOFTOP SOLAR PROGRAMME

General Definition of the Rooftop Solar Programme (RTS):

The RTS is a programme for grid - connected solar photovoltaic (PV) systems, either roof-mounted or ground - mounted, with or without energy storage. These systems are owned by consumers at the same location where they receive their electricity bill. The energy generated is primarily for self-use, with any excess generation eligible to be sold back to BPC.

Applying for Rooftop Solar



Individual or Domestic Applications:

To apply for rooftop solar as an individual or for a domestic setting, you must:

- Be a BPC customer.
- Provide a valid identification document (e.g., Omang [ID] or Passport).
- Provide a title deed or lease agreement for the plot where the rooftop solar will be installed.

Note: If you are not a BPC customer, you must also provide a letter of authorization from the meter owner, along with the above documents.



Commercial or Industrial Applications:

For commercial or industrial applications, you will need to provide:

- A Certificate of Incorporation.
- Consent from the Director(s).
- Valid identification documents for the Director(s) (e.g., Omang [ID] or Passport).
- A Share Certificate.

Note: If you are not a BPC customer, you must also provide a letter of authorization from the meter owner, along with the above documents.



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ROOFTOP SOLAR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for this program, a consumer must:

1. Be a BPC consumer,
 2. Install the rooftop system on the same property as the meter that will measure both consumption and export of electricity,
 3. Comply with the capacity and sizing limitations outlined below. Specifically, the following capacity limitations apply to this program:
- **Domestic:** Up to 35 kW of generating capacity. The applicant will be awarded a maximum of 13.8 kW for single - phase systems and 35 kW for three - phase systems.
 - **Commercial & Industrial:** Up to 1 MW of generating capacity. The size of the system must not exceed 110% of the consumer's consumption over the 12 - month period immediately preceding the date of application.

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
